

Grubbing and Fire Rake

The most durable tool for removing underbrush and vines. A premiere "land clearing" tool. This is the same tool used by the USDA Forest Service. Also found in many fire departments. It was originally created for the construction of fire lines.

- Four 3-1/4" long cutting teeth, specially sharpened and hardened, riveted to a very strong iron frame
- Tamp down style handle socket for breakdown ease
- 60" American ash handle with long grain structure for added strength, and round eye detail
- Head replacement and a replacement tooth pack are available
