

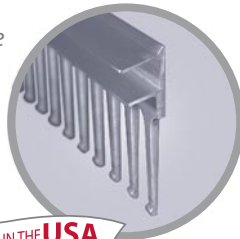

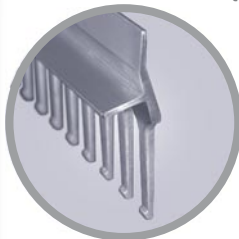

This handle hugging design distributes stress across the surface of the handle, reducing movement and wear at the brace-to-handle connection.
