

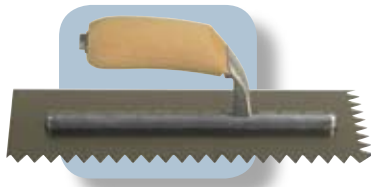
Trowels & Floats MADE IN THE USA

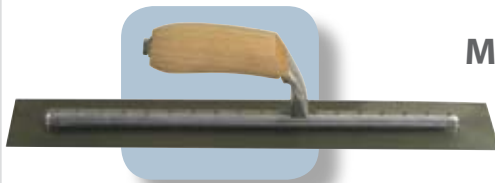

Flexible Radius Trowel

This is a flexible tool for coating and sealing many of the most difficult areas that need to be well sealed. You can't limit this tool to a single use; it has cross-over coating applications in all of the markets we serve, from floor coating to waterproofing, roofing, etc.

★ Smoother/Spreader

This tool is lightweight, yet durable. It features a 22" frame with a 23-1/2" x 2" heat-treated steel blade, fan-shaped for next to wall coverage, and a reversible "threaded" handle adapter assembly allowing for use as a smoother or spreader. Spread material with the blade in a vertical position (see below). Flip the tool over and smooth the surface as shown. This is a "core" tool...
